



MEDICAL DIRECTOR

Volunteers in Medicine Clinic of Lane County, a 501 (c) 3 non-profit medical clinic, is actively seeking a Primary Care Physician to join our well-respected clinic to serve as Medical Director of a volunteer staff of 40+ physicians including active and retired primary care and specialists.

We are recruiting a team-oriented clinical leader. The position will combine supervisory support and oversight for volunteer providers as well as direct patient care. This unique leadership position is for a non-profit free clinic known for its supportive, collaborative and friendly environment. All care is provided free of charge. An on-site Charitable pharmacy and a strong pro-bono network means that appropriate care can be obtained for patients, even though they do not have insurance. The position is four days a week for a total of 32 hours.

Since the majority of patients are Latino, strong preference is given to candidates fluent in Spanish, although this is not a strict requirement.

The most common comment we hear from our volunteers is that they love being able to really focus on the practice of medicine on behalf of grateful patients, and you will too.

REQUIREMENTS

Education:

- Successful completion of an accredited residency program in primary care (either family practice or internal medicine)
- Board Eligibility or Certification in either FP or IM

Licensure/Certification/Registration

- Must have current Oregon license as MD or DO
- Must maintain unrestricted DEA number

Experience

- Experience in outpatient clinical care, preferably with underserved populations
- Prefer fluency in Spanish.
